

POSITION TITLE: Therapist (Contract – Part time) IOP Classes

CLASSIFICATION: Clinical (Exempt)

WORK SCHEDULE: Flexible work schedule as assigned. May require some weekend and / or evening duty. **PRN.**

RESPONSIBILITIES: Provides direct therapeutic and educational services to clients using individual, group and family therapy; applies a variety of psychological methods and techniques in screening, assessment and evaluation of clients identified as substance abusers/chemically dependent; develops client centered treatment plans with specific goals and objectives and provides therapeutic counseling in accordance with such plans; maintains clinical records in accordance with Department of Mental Health Standards and agency policies and procedures; provides referrals to other social service agencies as appropriate; performs case management responsibilities including conducting human service needs assessments; performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS: Master's degree in a clinical area with a supervised practicum as part of graduate level coursework preferred. Supervised experience in the field of addictive disease/substance abuse treatment preferred. Certification as a qualified substance abuse professional per DMH standards desired.
